

# 2021 Spring Semester at the University of Seville (US)

## Dates

February 14 to May 13, 2021 (application deadline November 22, 2020)

## Academic Program

This Semester program at the University of Seville (US) is designed for university students who have a B2 level of Spanish or English and wish to earn up to 36 ECTS credits toward their major or minor in Spanish Language and Culture or International Studies. Students take their choice of courses in Humanities, Business, Arts, Education, Spanish Language, etc. taught by University of Seville professors. Students learn alongside Spanish and international students at the University's 16<sup>th</sup> century building during one Semester or longer. The program fee includes academic tuition, study trips, cultural activities and immersion activities with Spanish students, student support and 24/7 personal emergency assistance.

Students are lodged in a carefully screened Spanish family homestay with full board in a single or double room with shared bath, including housecleaning and weekly laundry double room.
