

Program Description

This program is designed for students who wish to study one or two courses of **Intermediate Spanish Language and Culture levels I and II** for 4 or 8 weeks in June and July, 2021 at the Instituto Español de Estudios Interculturales in Seville, Spain. Students experience a homestay, attend 3-hour sessions per day, on Monday through Friday mornings, and earn 3 or 6 credits. Students participate in guided visits to outstanding cultural sites, and activities of immersion in Spanish daily life to make the most of their experience in this bustling city.

Students receive 60 hours per term of language instruction in vocabulary, grammar and practice in the four skills, with emphasis on pronunciation, to improve the student's communication. Guided on-site language practice with locals, cultural investigations and individual and group projects are an essential part of the course during the students study time. Through this practical, communication-based course students improve their fluency and become increasingly confident in the language.

Program Dates for 2021

- May 29 to June 26, 2021 (4 weeks)
- June 26 to July 24, 2021 (4 weeks)
- May 29 to July 24, 2021 (8 weeks)

For either program students will arrive on Saturday before the first class and depart on Saturday after the final exam.

Prerequisites

- For enrollment in **Intermediate Spanish I**: two semesters of college Spanish Language or the equivalent.
- For enrollment in **Intermediate Spanish II**: completion of one semester of college Intermediate Spanish language or the equivalent.

Textbook

The textbook(s) is (are) included in the program fee and will be given to the student on the first day of classes.

Program Dates Term 1: 4 weeks

- Saturday, May 29, 2021: Arrival in Sevilla. Pick-up at the airport and transportation to homestay accommodation.
- Sunday, May 30, 2021: Orientation, Welcome Reception and city visits
- Monday, May 31, 2021: Classes begin.
- Friday, June 11, 2021: First exam.
- Friday, June 25, 2021: Final exam. Last days of classes (4-week program only).
- Saturday, June 26, 2021 End of program and housing (4-week program only).

Program Dates Term 2: 8 weeks

- Saturday, June 26, 2021: Arrival in Sevilla. Pick-up at the airport and transportation to homestay accommodation.
- Sunday, June 27, 2021: Orientation, Welcome Reception and city visits
- Monday, June 28, 2021: Classes start for SPAN162 - 4 week program only. Classes resume for 8-week program.
- Friday, July 9, 2021: First exam.
- Friday, July 23, 2021: Final exam. Last Day of classes.
- Saturday, July 24, 2021: End of program and homestay.

Study Trips and Visits

The program includes guided Study Visits to Seville's emblematic monuments and museums, such as the Cathedral, Alcazar Royal Palace, Fine Arts Museum; One day-excursion to Córdoba; One overnight trip to Granada (in the 8-week program).

Lodging and Meals

Students are lodged with full board in a carefully screened Spanish family homestay or a Student Residence in a double room with shared bath, including housecleaning and weekly laundry. Limited single rooms are available at request. Lodging starts on Saturday before the course start date and ends the day after the last class.

Program Fee

Fee per Session includes:

- 60 hours of Spanish language and culture instruction plus on-site investigation and projects guidance.
- Textbooks and class materials
- Homestay accommodation (room and full board)
- 6 guided study visits to monuments and museums in Seville
- 1 day-excursion to Córdoba per 4-week session.
- 1 overnight study trip to Granada per two 4-week sessions.
- Participation in other school activities such as Welcome Reception, occasional celebrations, special events, group gatherings, etc.
- Use of school facilities
- Individual pick-up at Seville airport and transportation to homestay accommodation.
- Full coverage student health insurance for the duration of the program
